Mr. Ortwein: Is there any difference between students' accounts and teachers' accounts?

Yichen: Yes, students can only search for certain products, modify the information of certain materials, and put materials into their team stocks. Teachers are allowed to purchase the materials for the club which can't be done through students' accounts.

Mr. Ortwein: Can teachers' accounts have access to students' team stock?

Yichen: Not yet.

Mr. Ortwein: I strongly recommend you to have a page which allows teachers to check the stock of each team. This can help teachers make a better prediction about which kind of material do teams need. This is just a usability thing. Besides that, I hope that you put team stock into a separate page. This can make the teacher easier to access.

Yichen: Do you have any suggestions about the design of the pages?

Mr. Ortwein: I think the design of the students account is fine. For teachers' accounts, I hope that you move the tab for team stock to the end.

Mr. Ortwein: I also hope that your data can be stored in a local file. You know that it is always important to store a hard copy about all the important information about the materials. I hope that you can design a save button. Once I click the save button, the update can be automatically saved to the local files.

Mr. Ortwein: you mentioned that your program can generate a recommended list for purchase. This is a very useful feature which will help me to make a better purchase decision. However, I also hope that students can request for certain material which will help teachers to know which kind of materials are most needed.
