

Q1: Thank you for meeting with me again, I hope that you enjoyed what my product had to offer, and I understand that there are perhaps some things you didn't like about it. For one, when I'm searching for a task, I'll only really use the name to search for other attributes. I also think that because I am able to sort data, I don't necessarily need to be able to calculate a percentage completion. One or the other works for me.

Q5: Got it. I did put in some new things which I'm sure you were aware of... mainly to increase the user friendliness - the pop-up messages for example, but also the refreshing of text fields to provide a clean page for you to re-enter data in. How helpful was this?

A5: Super. I appreciate both the pop-up messages and the text clearing. The pop-ups allowed me to know that whatever action I took was actually registered by the program, and the text field clearing was just a feature that made things more efficient. So yes, it did enhance the usability.
